Nashville General Hospital serves as the primary teaching hospital for Meharry Medical College as well as a teaching site for Vanderbilt University. First opening as City Hospital on April 23, 1890, on Hermitage Avenue, Nashville General Hospital relocated to the Meharry campus in January 1998. The relocation highlights the blending of two rich medical histories to provide one of the best healthcare facilities in the area. The Joint Commission accredited facility readily accommodates a wide range of acute care needs, including a post-operative surgical floor, medical floor, adult and neonatal intensive care units and full OB/Gyn services. The medical and surgical staffs are dedicated to providing comprehensive, high quality care to patients and their families.*
