There are no deposit refunds, for any reason. The program is NOT a Title IV participant through the Federal Department of Education. This means our students are NOT ELIGIBLE for Federal Student Aid (government-funded student loans or deferments). **Tuition Loans:** The Nashville General Hospital Credit Union currently offers education loans for students enrolled in the Radiologic Technology program. As long as enrolled, students may be eligible for a loan up to \$9,000 for three years at 12% APR.
